




A. By Gender




B. By Type of Cleft








TOTAL BORN with only a cleft lip without a cleft palate: **161 children** (14.4%)


Unilateral without a cleft palate	137	12.2 %

TOTAL BORN with only a cleft palate without a cleft lip: 63 children (5.6 %).




C. By Type of Cleft Lip




TOTAL BORN with a unilateral cleft lip, with or without cleft palate: 729 children (65.2%).

In the statistics you see there is a total of 24 bilateral cleft lips without a cleft palate. The family above has a total of 7 members born with a bilateral cleft lip without a cleft palate.




